

German Upper Intermediate Course - B2-1

Objective

To achieve language level B2, the upper intermediate level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF).

Description

This is the **first** part of the course B2, which we offer in **two** modules: B2-1 and B2-2. After the completion of **both modules**, i.e. the full B2 course, you will be able to:

- understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialization,
- interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party,
- produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options,
- use grammatical structures: e.g. reported speech, indefinite pronouns, nominalization of nouns.

The textbook used in the course will be

The course will take place on Campus Westend.

At the end of the course, participants who participated in 80% of the course will receive a certificate of completion.
